Ervad Zarrir Bhandara: On Jan 9th, in a groundbreaking moment of interfaith understanding, the City of Orange invited Ervad Zarrir Bhandara to deliver the invocation for their Epiphany meeting. This historic gesture not only celebrated the diverse tapestry of religious beliefs in the city but also resonated with the Zoroastrian faiths core principles of "Good Thoughts, Good Words, Good Deeds."

Ervad Bhandaras captivating speech transported the audience, which included city officials, residents & members of the medical & social work communities, on a journey through Zoroastrianisms rich history and its emphasis on environmental respect, inclusivity & universal human rights. He drew parallels to the legacy of

Emperor Cyrus the Great: a pioneer of human rights, whose decrees inspired the Universal Declaration of Human Rights and influenced the American Constitution.
